

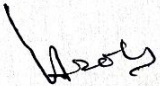


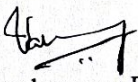

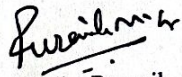

- 1) NAME OF THE CHAPTER:- : " **REGIONAL CHAPTER OF ANATOMY**"
- 2) REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE CHAPTER : C/o Dr. Vasanti Arole,
R/a - Flat No. N - 3, 1st Floor, Sneh Paradise co-op Hsg Soc, Buldg N S. No. 123/A/1/1 Kothrud Pune - 411 038.
- 3) JURISDICTION :-
Will be whole of Maharashtra
- (1) INTERPRETATIONS :-
- A) Chapter :-
Means the society the name of which appears in the Memorandum of Association.
- B) Society Registration Act :-
Means the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- C) Objects :-
Those occurring in Clause No. (4) of the Memorandum of Association.
- D) Members :-
Mean who have been accepted as members by the Executive Committee of the Chapter, and whose name duly appear in the membership register of the Chapter.
- E) Executive Committee :-
It means the Executive Committee in which the powers of management of this Chapter have been vested.

F) Anatomical Society of India (ASI): Means the parent Body of this Chapter which is registered Society under the provisions of Society Registration Act, 1860 in Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh).

(2) JURISDICTION :- At present the jurisdiction of the Chapter is Maharashtra which will be increased according to the progress of the Chapter to all over India and overseas.

(3) MEMBER OF THE CHAPTER IS A PERSON WHO :

A) To become member of the Chapter, one has to be the member of parent body (ASI) first.

B) In order to be a member of the Chapter, a candidate satisfying the provisions for membership shall be proposed by an existing life member and seconded by another. The member shall then be declared as a member of the chapter in the category for which he applies and on the final approval of the proposal by the Executive Committee

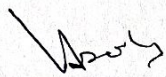
C) An application form for membership shall have to be duly filled in by the candidate and signed by himself as well as by his proposer and seconder.

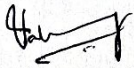
D) Validity of membership would only accrue after the scheduled fee and appropriate subscription are duly received by the Treasurer.

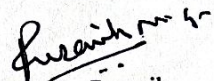
E) A new member shall be considered a valid member only after his/her subscription has been received by the Treasurer and after his enrollment has been approved by the Executive Committee, and who has accepted to abide by the Rules and Regulations of this Chapter.

F) The Chapter reserves the right to make and enroll new members, and any membership application can be rejected by the Executive Committee without giving any reason whatsoever.

G) Enrolment Fees :- All members shall pay Rs. 100/- as enrolment fee and Rs. 50/- towards incidentals. In case of discontinuance of membership, for any reason the fee will not be refunded. A


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member, having once discontinued membership for any reason shall pay a readmission fee of Rs. 100/- and incidental charges of Rs. 50/- i.e. the applicant who seeks membership once again.

H) Arrears of Subscription:- The responsibility of regular payment of the annual membership subscription would rest with the member himself/herself. Any member defaulting in making payment of his/her annual membership subscription up to 31st October each year shall ipso facto forfeit all the privileges of membership. Names of such defaulting member would be communicated to the Executive Committee who may recommend the removal of their names from the list of members for final consideration in the upcoming Executive Committee meeting and Annual General Body Meeting of the Chapter.

(4) TYPES OF MEMBERS :

A) Founder Member :-

Founder member is a person who is signatory to the Memorandum of Association of the Chapter, and whose membership fees amount is Rs. 3500/-. Founder members will remain as life members by paying the above fees/subscription.

B) Ordinary Member :-

Ordinary member is a person who is or was engaged at any time in the teaching of any of the scheduled subjects and/or carrying out postgraduate work on the same in a University, recognized institution or laboratory shall be eligible for enrolment as an ordinary member. The annual subscription for the ordinary members with eligible qualifications shall be Rs. 1000/-. The subscriptions are payable within the first month of each year.

C) Life Member :-

Any individual with a degree with special status in Anatomy i.e. MS/MD/M.Sc/Ph.D/DNB post graduate, working in Maharashtra, may become life member on request, with the

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approval of Executive Committee and after making onetime payment of Rs. 3500/- towards all future subscriptions.

D) Associate Life Members:-

An individual with other qualification and from outside Maharashtra; Anatomists from Allopathy, Dental, Physiotherapy, Occupational therapy, Nursing, Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani Colleges may become an Associate life member on request and with the approval of the Executive Committee and after making a onetime payment of Rs. 3500/- towards all future subscriptions.

E) PG Life Members/Associate PG Life Member:-

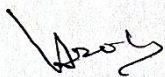
An individual doing PG degree in Anatomy in Maharashtra may become a PG life member on request, with the approval of the Executive Committee and after making a onetime payment of Rs. 2000/- towards all future subscriptions. PG life membership is valid for three years only. He/She may become regular life member after paying the difference otherwise. An individual doing degree outside Maharashtra may become Associate PG Life member, with onetime payment of Rs. 2000/-.

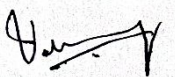
F) Student Member:-

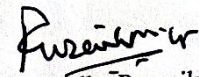
An UG/PG Anatomy Medical student may become ordinary member on request, with the approval of the Executive Committee after making a yearly subscription of Rs. 500/-. The subscription is to be paid in the first month of every year. Student members are not allowed to participate in the General Body Meeting.

G) Honorary Member:-

Any person with outstanding scientific attainments in any of the scheduled subjects or any person who has rendered or is likely to render material service in advancing the objectives of the chapter may be admitted as an Honorary Member of the Chapter for such period as the Executive Committee may think fit and proper. An Honorary Member shall be entitled to participate in the

deliberations of the Chapter at its General Meetings, but shall not be eligible to vote on any matter.

H) Patrons :-

The Chapter, at its annual meeting, shall have powers to invite Patron who are person with outstanding eminence and whose association with the Chapter is likely to be benefited^{ed} in furtherance of its objectives. The minimum contribution from a Patron shall be Rs. 1, 00,000/- (Rupees one lakhs).

I) Fellows of the Chapter:-

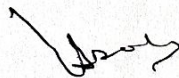
Founder members will be conferred fellowship of the Chapter in due course of time.

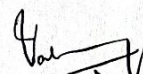
Privileges of Ordinary, Associate Life Members, Life Members, and student Members:-

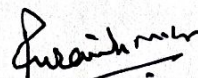
- a) Members (except student members) shall have the right to be present in all General body Meeting^s of the Chapter.
- b) All Life members, Associate Life Members, PG life Members shall be entitled to receive the Journal of the Chapter, free of cost.
- c) All members shall have the right to present papers of communications at the Annual Conference or any special session.
- d) All life members shall have right to propose or second the names of for new entrants for membership.
- e) Only life members shall have a right to contest or vote for the election of the Chapter.
- f) A student member (UG/PG) will be entitled to attend the conference and may present a paper.

(5) CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP :

- A) Any member (except Honorary members & Patrons) shall be liable to have their names removed from the list of members.


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- B) In case of ordinary members if the subscription is in arrears for more than 3 years including the current year, the member's name will be automatically removed from the list of members without reference to the General Body.
- C) If in the opinion of the Executive Committee and in the interest of the chapter, if termination of one's membership is considered desirable, such termination shall be finally decided by voting in a General Body meeting by minimum 1/3rd majority of members present.
- D) Office Bearers and Executive Committee members are liable for termination if found indulged in any type of malpractices or criminal activity, that may be harmful for the chapter.
- E) In case a member resigns from his/her membership in writing and provided the resignation is so accepted by the Executive Committee.
- F) If a member dies or becomes lunatic.
- G) If a member is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.

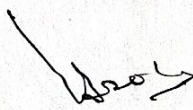
(6) WAY OF FILLING IN VACANCY IN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE :

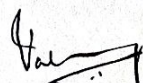
If any vacancy occurs in the Executive Committee members/trustees on account of disqualification of member or on account of vacancy due to death or resignation or if a member desires to be discharged or relieved from the membership, then the continuing or surviving members shall appoint a new member in the vacancy, "caused by majority", from amongst the members. The person so appointed in the vacancy created shall work only for the remaining term.

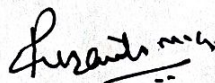
(7) AUTHORITIES OF CHAPTER :

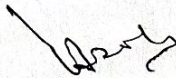

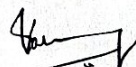

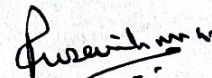


(8) GENERAL BODY:

- 1) The General Body shall consist of all categories of members except student member.
- 2) The General Body shall normally meet once in a year at the time of Annual Conference or more often, if required.
- 3) The meeting of the General Body shall be presided over by the President or in his absence by the Vice President and in their absence by a member so elected from the Executive Committee, or in special circumstances a person from the General Body.
- 4) 1/3rd of the existing members on record shall form a quorum at a meeting of the General Body.
- 5) If at a duly convened meeting of the General Body, there be no quorum at the time announced for the meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting shall be held after half an hour for which there is no necessity of the requisite quorum. However, the same agenda will be considered at the adjourned meeting.
- 6) All matters placed before the General Body for which no higher majority is prescribed, shall be decided by simple majority or show of hands, or by ballot, if demanded by any ten or more members present. In case of equality of votes, the President of the meeting shall have a Casting Vote.
- 7) The Secretary in consultation with the President shall convene the meeting of the General Body with at least fifteen (15) days clear notice. The notice of the meeting shall contain a specific agenda to be discussed at the meeting. The said notice shall be sent by post, courier or can be given by hand or by any other method as per the choice of the President to all members.
- 8) The General Body at its Annual General meeting shall :-
 - (a) Consider and approve the Annual Report of the Chapter as presented by the Secretary.
 - (b) Consider and adopt the audited statement of accounts for the previous year.


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- (c) Consider the budget estimates of the Chapter for the following year.
- (d) Consider the resolutions and amendments, referred to it by the Executive Committee or by the member of the Chapter.
- (e) Appoint Auditors and Legal Advisors for the ensuing year.
- (f) Transact such other business as may be brought forward with permission of the President.
- (g) Elect Executive Committee members after every three (3) years.

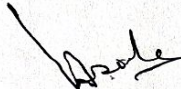
(9) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE :

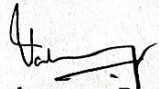
A) The management and control of the Chapter shall be at present vested in an Executive Committee of 9 members. The number of Executive Committee shall be minimum 9 (Nine) members which can be further extended to maximum 15 (fifteen) OR as the Chapter decided. The Executive Committee shall continue to hold office till a new Executive Committee is elected.

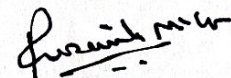
As the Anatomical Society of India (ASI) is the parent body of this Chapter, the chapter will abide by the constitution, Rules and Regulation of the parent body, and will seek the guidance of the parent body as and when necessary. Also the composition of the Executive Committee will change as per the directions of the parent body.

B) TENURE OF OFFICE BEARER AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The tenure of elected office bearer except President & Vice - President is of Three (3) Years. They can be office bearer of each post for not more than two consecutive office terms. The term of President, Vice - President & elected Executive Committee members is of one (1) year. The Secretary, Treasurer and Editor will hold their office for three (3) year.


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C) The Executive Committee shall consist of the following office bearers :

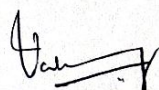
- 1) President
- 2) Vice - President
- 3) Secretary
- 4) Treasurer
- 5) Editor

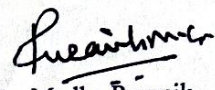
If any of the office bearers die, or resign from the post of office bearer, the Executive Committee shall be entitled to appoint a new office bearer in the vacancy. The office bearer so appointed in the vacancy shall work only for the remaining term of office.

(10) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE :-(MEETING, NOTICE & QUORUM)

- a) The President shall preside at all the meetings of the Executive Committee. In his absence, the Vice-President shall preside over the meeting, and in absence of both, the Executive Committee shall elect/select one of its member to preside at the meeting.
- b) 1/3rd members shall form a quorum at the meeting of the Executive Committee. If at a duly convened meeting of the Executive Committee, there be no quorum at the time announced for the meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting shall be held after half an hour for which there is no necessity of the quorum. However, the same agenda will be considered at the adjourned meeting.
- c) All matters placed before the Executive Committee shall be decided by 1/3rd majority of votes taken by show of hands. In case of equality of votes, the President of the meeting shall be entitled to a Casting Vote.
- d) The Executive Committee shall meet once in year or more often as thought fit and proper.
- e) Notice of Executive Committee meeting shall be sent eight (8) clear days in advance before the meeting by Ordinary Post, courier, by hand or by any other method to be decided by the President.

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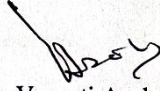

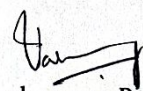

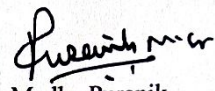


(11) POWERS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE :

- 1) To frame regulations consistent with this constitution for :-
 - a) The conduct of its business,
 - b) The conduct of its meeting, and
 - c) To manage the affairs of the Chapter.
- 2) To arrange the conference for the Chapter.
- 3) To publish the Journal of the Chapter.
- 4) To solicit, obtain and/or accept subscriptions, donations, grants, gifts, devices, bequest from any society, person, firm, corporation or institutions or a likewise body.
- 5) To hold movable and immovable properties of the Chapter and to administer its funds.
- 6) To consider and recommend for adoption by the General Body the annual budgetary provisions for the ensuing year of the Chapter.
- 7) To prepare the draft of the annual reports and financial Statements of the Chapter, and recommend the same to the General Body for their sanctions, & to arrange for its circulation among the members.
- 8) To consider and sanction proposals for extra expenditure.
- 9) To construct, maintain, extend, improve, repair, alter, enlarge, and modify any land, house, buildings or such type of work necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Chapter.
- 10) To enter into, vary, carry or cancel contracts on behalf of the Chapter.
- 11) To take steps with a view to preventing a member or any other employee from doing anything or acting in any manner or performing any act of commission or omission detrimental to the interest of the Chapter.
- 12) To fill vacancies in the Executive Committee caused by death, resignation or absence without leave of a member or members for three consecutive meetings. However failure to fill in such vacancy or vacancies during the interval shall not vitiate the


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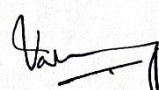


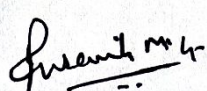
- proceedings and affairs of the Executive Committee but shall be discharged by the remaining members of the Executive Committee, during the interval.
- 13) To consider and if thought fit, sanction proposals for the appointment of needs of institutions, and members of establishments in each institution of the Chapter.
 - 14) To appoint, confirm, promote or terminate the services of any employee working in the Societies & its branches of the Chapter.
 - 15) To fix the salaries and allowances to be paid or made to the employees of the Chapter in its various institutions.
 - 16) To appoint a Committee, if required, by the name 'Advisory Board' for the said Chapter, if deemed necessary and to fix its tenure. To dissolve/ change the members thereof if circumstances so warrant.
 - 17) To take over, associate with or tie-up with or to amalgamate with any other Chapter or Association having similar or in part similar objectives of the Chapter.
 - 18) To appoint internal auditors, Chartered Accountants for the Chapter.
 - 19) Generally to do all such acts and things as may be necessary or desirable in the interest of the Chapter whether they are expressly provided in the rules or not.

(12) PROVISION FOR LOAN/DEPOSITS AND INVESTMENT :

- 1) To raise loans/deposits, if necessary, on the security of the movable or immovable properties, and/or by mortgaging the properties of the Chapter.
- 2) To open, invest and operate all accounts of any description with any Co - Operative, Multi State Scheduled Bank, Nationalized or Multi National bank and to invest and deal with any money of the Chapter not immediately required for any of its objects under section 35 of the Bombay Public Chapter Act, 1950.


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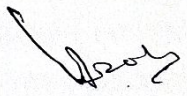
(13) PROVISION FOR PURCHASE AND SALE OF IMMOVABLE PROPERTY

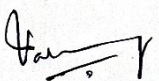
- 1) To acquire by gift, purchase, exchange, lease, hire or otherwise any lands, buildings, assets, rights of any property, movable and/or immovable and any estate or interest for the Chapter.
- 2) To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire or to give its property on lease or hire as may be deemed necessary or convenient.
- 3) To sell, dispose off any property or any part thereof as may be considered necessary or convenient in the best interest of the Chapter as per Section 36 of the B.P.T. Act, 1950.
- 4) No act or proceedings of the Chapter shall be deemed to be invalid by a reason merely of any vacancy in and/or defect or deficiency in the construction of Memorandum of Association of the Chapter/ Rules and Regulations thereof as the case may be.

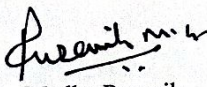
(14) DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS :

1) PRESIDENT :-

- a) To preside, and chair the General Body, and the meetings of the Executive Committee as provided in the Rules.
- b) To decide all matters/issues by majority of votes.
- c) The right to call any meeting in case of urgency, and in the failure of Secretary calling the meeting.
- d) To keep control over the staff of the Chapter.
- e) To deliver casting vote in case of a tie.
- f) President is entitled to keep in hand an amount not exceeding Rs. 5,000/- for day to day expenses.
- g) To do all acts in order to promote the general welfare of the Chapter.


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2) VICE - PRESIDENT:

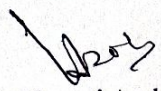
The vice - President have all the powers of the President in the absence of President.

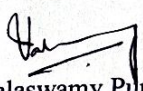
3) SECRETARY :

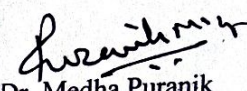
- a) To convene all meetings of the Executive Committee and the General Body in consultation with the President.
- b) To write the minutes of the meetings.
- c) To carry on correspondence for the Executive Committee and General Body in consultation with the President.
- d) To arrange and keep the records of the Chapter up-to-date.
- e) To keep and maintain a list of the properties of the Chapter.
- f) To maintain the General Registers of the members of the Chapter.
- g) To implement the regulations of the General Body and the Executive Committee.
- h) To correspond on behalf of the Chapter and represent the Chapter in legal matters.
- i) Secretary is entitled to keep in hand an amount not exceeding Rs. 10,000/- for day to day expenses.
- j) To perform and to do all the duties in the interest of the Chapter as assigned to him/her by the General Body, and the Executive Committee of the Chapter.

4) TREASURER :

- a) He is responsible for all the sums of money which are from time to time received by the Chapter.
- b) To see and maintain accounts of the Chapter and its institutions.
- c) To get the accounts of the Chapter audited, and present the statement of accounts to the Annual General Body.
- d) To present the budget to the Executive Committee, for consideration and sanction.

5) EDITOR :

To accept research articles, to get them reviewed, to run and publish the Journals of the Chapter regularly.

6) MEMBERS :

- a) To help the Executive Committee for the smooth function of the Chapter.
- b) To participate in the meeting of General Body of the Chapter.


(15) EXTRA ORDINARY/REQUISITION MEETING OF GENERAL BODY:


Such meeting shall be held within 30 days if the requisition by at least 1/3rd of the total number of members on roll provided that the request is made in writing to the President stating the business proposed to be discussed. The notice for this meeting should be 15 days in advance. No other business shall be discussed at the Extra-ordinary meeting other than the specific purpose for which the meeting is being called.

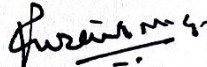
Decisions shall be taken by a simple majority. The President shall have a casting vote in case of a tie. The quorum for the transaction of business shall be 1/3rd members. In the event of quorum not being present within half an hour for the time set for the meeting, the meeting shall stand adjourned and re-assemble after half an hour. At such adjourned meeting, the rule of quorum shall not apply.

(15) VOTING RIGHTS :

Only life member of the Chapter will have the right for one vote to be exercised at the General Body meeting. All decisions will be arrived at in the Executive Committee as well as in the General


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Body Meeting by a majority vote. In the event of a tie, the presiding person i.e. the President shall have the power of deciding the issue by a casting vote. Members who are in arrears of their annual subscription will not be entitled to :-

- a) Vote at the Annual General Body Meeting.
- b) Present paper/posters at the conference.

(17) FUNDS :

The funds of the Chapter shall consist of subscriptions, and donations and such other funds received from whatever source, and the same shall be deposited in any Co - Operative, Multi State Scheduled Bank, Nationalized or Multi National bank or Public Securities approved by the Executive Committee.

The income, money and properties of the Chapter, in whatsoever manner derived, shall be applied solely towards the maintenance, upkeep and improvement of the chapter and properties of the Chapter and for acquisition of new ones, and for the promotion of all or any of the objectives specified above and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of profit to the members of the Chapter, PROVIDED and howsoever that nothing herein shall prevent in good faith remuneration to any member in return for any service rendered to the Chapter.

The Chapter may establish general, special or capital funds for furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Chapter, and the money shall be deposited in Co - Operative, Multi State Scheduled Bank, Nationalized, Multi National banks or Public Securities.

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(18) ACCOUNTING YEAR :

The accounting year of the Chapter shall be from 1st of April to 31st March each year.

(19) BANK ACCOUNT :

The Bank Accounts shall be opened in the name of the Chapter in any Nationalized or Schedule Bank and shall be operated jointly by any two of three office bearer i.e. President, Treasurer and Secretary. In special circumstances the account can be operated by other than this office bearer but in that case the resolution should be passed by the Executive Committee and power should be given to any one person of the Executive Committee.

(20) CHANGE AMENDMENT IN THE NAME AND OBJECT :

To alter, extend, amend or change the name, and/or the objectives of the Chapter, however, provisions of Sections 12 and 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, shall be complied with.

(21) CHANGE IN RULES AND REGULATIONS :

Any change to be done in the Rules and Regulations will be done by calling special General Body meeting and 3/5th of the total number of members should be present for the said meeting and the said change should be accepted in the said meeting by majority. A copy of proposed change(s) in Rules and Regulations shall be sent along with Notice to the members well in advance.

(22) LIST OF MEMBERS :

The list of persons who are members within the meaning of Section

15 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, shall be maintained in the form of Schedule VI to the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) Rules, 1971, vide Rules 15 thereof.

(23) INDEMNITY :

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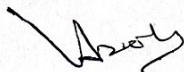
- 1) The office bearers and the members of the Chapter shall be indemnified in respect of acts done by them for the Chapter in good faith, and no office bearer or member of the Chapter shall be liable for such act done by any other office bearer, or member of the Chapter.
- 2) No act or proceedings of the Chapter shall be deemed to be invalid by a reason merely of any vacancy in and/or defect or deficiency in the construction of Memorandum of Association of the Chapter/ Rules and Regulations thereof as the case may be.

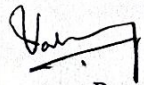
(24) SEAL:

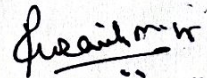
- 1) There shall be a common Seal of the Chapter which shall be affixed at the discretion of Executive Committee to such deeds, contracts, agreements and official letters, documents or statements of whatever nature where requires the sanction of the Executive Committee.
- 2) Sub - Committees:
The Chapter at its Annual General Body Meeting or the Executive Committee meeting during the course of the working year, shall have powers to appoint subcommittees for specific purposes. Such subcommittees shall submit their report to the appointing body.
- 3) Parent Body:-
The Anatomical Society of India (ASI) registered Society under Society Registration Act, 1860 is the parent body of this Chapter. This Chapter will abide by the constitution, rules and regulations of the parent body and will seek the guidance of the parent body as and when necessary. Also will communicate the proceedings of the chapter to the parent body from time to time.

(25) ANNUAL CONFERENCE:

The conference of the chapter shall be held annually along with the Executive Committee Meeting and Annual General Body Meeting and the business at the conference shall consist of presentation of papers of communication demonstrations,


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discussions on Anatomical and other allied subjects and any other matter of academic interest as far as Anatomy and the scheduled subjects are concerned. The annual conference will be held to the extent possible in a Medical college of Maharashtra. A paper presented at the state chapter is permitted to be presented at the National level scientific forum.

(26) PROVISION FOR EXPENSES TO BE INCURRED ON OBJECTS :

If any amount is collected for some specific object, the said amount can be 100% spent for that object. Alternatively, such amounts can be spent on other objects as approved and decided by the Executive Committee from time to time. Or otherwise out of the income of the Chapter, at least 80% of the income shall be incurred on carrying out the objects of the Chapter and 20% income shall be incurred on administrative objects.

(27) DISSOLUTION :


If for any reasons it is decided to dissolve the Chapter, the provision of sec. 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, shall be complied with.
